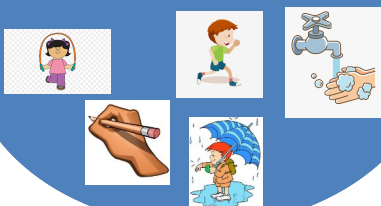

Reception Daily Home Learning

Time Spent	Area of Development
10 minutes	RE —Say our class prayers at the beginning, lunchtime and at the end of the day. Spend time each day thinking how we can be more like Jesus in our day to day lives as Christians during Lent.
20 minutes	Maths - A daily activity will be uploaded to Tapestry and can be completed alongside a Home Learning pack activity. It will be a mixture of Number/Shape, Space and Measure activities.
20 minutes	Literacy -A daily writing/reading activity will be uploaded to Tapestry and can be completed alongside a Home Learning pack activity.
20/30 minutes	Daily Reading - Read a Bug Club book and share read a storybook to develop children's love of reading and explore lots of story language.
60 minutes	Physical Development: Gross motor. When and where possible, get outside. If you have access to a garden, spend as much time as possible enjoying being outside. - running, skipping, hopping, jumping. Children need lots and lots of physical activity, so enjoy all the fresh air even if it is rainy! (See links to this on the other side of this page for fun indoor Physical sites too).
20 minutes	Physical Development: Fine Motor skills.—Fiddly Finger activity/Finger Gym activity/Dough Disco/Letter formation activities. There are lots of ideas for this on Pinterest. Youtube also has Dough disco songs.
20 minutes	Physical Development: Health & Self-Care—Talk about ways to keep healthy and safe and the importance of good practises in exercise, eating, sleeping and hygiene.
20 minutes	Understanding the World -Take opportunities to bake, go on a Spring Hunt and encourage your child to talk about what they are doing and what they find!
30 minutes	Expressive Arts and Design —Draw or paint a picture, make a model, role play, play with small world, develop careful scissor skills by practising cutting using some of the Home Learning pack ideas, etc
Unlimited	Communication & Language/Personal, Social and Emotional Development —Lots and lots of opportunities to talk, say how we feel, play games., build dens, play with lego. Take time just to talk and play!
