We have some wonderful texts we will still want to share with all the children and hope they will still enjoy these.

The weekly projects we have set will reflect the learning, but also are intended to give the children some practical, making and creating opportunities at home away from the laptop screen. Please be as creative with the projects as you can be, or complete them in a different way to our suggestions if you want to use your own idea.
