# **Christ the King News**

Dear Parents and Carers,

The number of positive Covid-19 cases has dropped slightly this week but is still of concern. Please be aware of the symptoms and if your child is unwell do not send them to school. Please do regular lateral flow tests twice a week as these have picked up several asymptomatic cases within our school and enabled us to prevent further cases. If the school advises you to book a PCR test due to your child being symptomatic, we do strongly advise you do this and report the result to school. Complying is for the benefit of our community and public health.

Several local schools have reported Covid-19 outbreaks – often these have been linked to parties and gatherings outside of school. Please be mindful of mixing before the run up to Christmas - reducing the mixing will reduce the spread of Covid.

#### **Christmas Nativities and Carols**


