

### English:

- Children will follow the RWI scheme learning how to read different sounds, write letters and form sentences.
- Children will develop their early writing skills including sentence structure, capital letters and full stops.
- Children will continue to develop and use adjectives and conjunctions in their writing.
- Children will engage with our focus texts Dragon Post, Zog and Jack and The Beanstalk.
- Children will use story maps and actions to learn the features of letter writing and stories.



## Year 1 Spring 2 2020–2021 The Enchanted land

### Music:

- Children will learn new sign-a-long songs and experiment using different instruments
- Children will learn to recognise the difference between Pulse and Rhythm

### Religious Education:

#### Meals

- Children will learn about the importance of relationships. They will learn the story of The Last Supper from the Bible.

#### Change

- Children will learn about life, especially family life, or life in school, and how they are full of opportunities for self-giving.

### Maths:

- Children will be introduced to vocabulary linking to measure and they will apply their knowledge of measure to problem solving activities.
- They will develop their number and understanding to 50 using tens frames, number lines and dienes.
- Children will learn to read and write numbers to 50 as well as write the numbers in word format e.g. 22 = twenty-two.
- Children will continue to develop their number fluency such as, number bonds to 10 and 20, counting forwards and backwards from any number to 20 and understanding the relationships

### Physical Education:

Core skills and Net Wall games:

- Children will learn basic net wall games.
- Children will continue to develop their core functional skills including, hopping, skipping, balancing, moving in different directions and throwing.

### Computing:

We are story tellers

- Children will learn how to create their own animated story books by drawing and animating pictures.

### History:

- Children will learn about important previous kings and queens in the past and their influence in history. These include: Henry VIII, Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria

- Children will learn about different privileges people are afforded.
