Safeguarding Updates

Boys should not have less than a grade 2 cut; patterns and artwork shaved along the side of the head are not suitable neither is a style that is stepped ie, very long on the top and very short sides.

Children should also be wearing sunscreen and hats to school in the fine weather for their protection.
