Workshops

Phonics and Reading Workshop

We would like to invite you all to our Phonics and Reading Workshop on Wednesday 26th September. We will begin at 2.15pm and you will have an opportunity to find out about how your child will be learning phonics, the early stages of reading and how you can support your child at home.

Maths Workshop

On Monday 1st October, you are invited to the Maths Workshop at 2.15pm where we will introduce how we teach Maths in the Early Years and give ideas for practical activities to support and develop your child's maths skills at home.

Reading

Next week, your child will have a reading book that they will bring home, to begin, these will be the books without words. Please remember to read with your child every day and record that they have read in their reading diaries. You may want to write a comment or just date and sign.

Reading Raffle: We will be starting the Reading Raffle where any child who has read their book at home earns a raffle ticket. At the end of the week, a raffle ticket is drawn at random and that child can choose from our special prize box. The more the children read at home, the more raffle tickets they will have in the pot!

Reading Race Track: By reading at home and signing your child's reading record, the children will move their way along our 'Reading Race Track' to gain their certificate. Reading records should be signed daily as the children read so they can earn up to 7 signatures a week if they read every day!

Certificates: Pink - 25 signatures, Bronze - 50 signatures, Silver - 75 signatures, Gold - 100 signatures, Diamond - 150 signatures, Platinum - 200 signatures, Ruby - 250 signatures,

Emerald - 300 signatures

Keep your eyes on future newsletters as we celebrate the children achieving their reading certificates.
