Dear Parents,

We hope you've all had an enjoyable half term with your loved ones. Thank you for all of your support throughout the last half term, the learning attitudes of your children have been excellent. Soon it will be Christmas and we will be starting a new year!

Thank you for supporting your children in gaining access to our online learning platforms—these play a crucial role in setting home learning tasks to minimise paper contact.

The expectations for this half term remain the same; we expect children to be reading (with a signature) and completing spellings daily. Homework will continue to be set on a Friday and collected in on a Wednesday. We will endeavour to set homework that is 'paperless' although some homework will be set on paper.

Our new topic for this half term is Cataclysmic Earthquakes! This topic links to our overarching South America topic, where lots of earthquakes occur. Throughout the half term, the children will participate in many enriching activities to enhance their understanding of how, why and when these phenomena take place.

Please remember that your children's attendance and punctuality is paramount, we start teaching at **8.30am**; this is the time that we expect **all children** to be in our classrooms.
