Dear Parents,

We hope you've all had a safe, healthy and restful Easter with your families. We would like to say thank you for all of your support throughout the last term. As always your support goes a long way and this reflects in your child's attitude in class, which has been fantastic. Our new topic for this half term is Ancient Greece! This is a history-based topic which includes lots of practical activities that will support the children's learning. Your child will be learning about the following:

 Study of Greek life, study of Greek philosophers/ scholars, their achievements and their influence on the Western world

• The legacy of Greek culture (architecture, mythology and literature)

To enrich our topic, the children will participate in two Greek experience days! This will include the children being able to plan, design, make and evaluate Greek sculptures/models including:

- Chariots
- Vase/clay pottery
- Puppets (sewing)

The expectations for this half term remain the same; we expect children to be reading (with a signature) and completing spellings daily. Homework will continue to be set **on a Friday and collected in on a Thursday**.

Please remember that your children's attendance and punctuality is paramount, we start teaching at **8.30am**; this is the time that we expect **all children** to be in our classrooms. Year 5 children can walk to and from school entrance/exits; we will need a signed letter giving permission.
