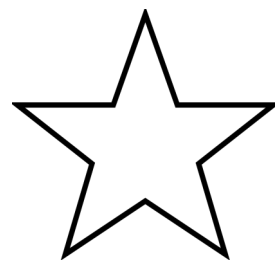

Home Learning

Please continue to read with your child daily and practise their sounds in their letters and sounds folders. Play tricky word games and activities —matching pairs/snap etc. Please encourage your child to talk about their day using whole sentences eg "I went to the park" rather than just "park", still supporting them to use the correct tense when they speak eg. "I **did** this" instead of "I done this". Play number games and spot car/house numbers when you are out and about to help number recognition.
