Safeguarding Updates

We have been made aware of a popular website that is in fact not what it seems <u>musical.ly</u>. This is an app that encourages children to make and share short videos. What is shown is actually shared by more than just this site, Facebook, Instagram, vine, Twitter, What's app and more can easily access all that was put on it. Even creating a privacy account does not hide your details.

The Safer Schools Community Team, (Safe guarding branch of the police) recommend parents ban this app as there is too much risk involved. **It's ok to say NO to your child!**

Health and Safety

As of September 2018 we are extending the NUT FREE rule to the whole school. Peanut and tree nut allergies account for most fatal and near-fatal anaphylactic reactions. Allergic individuals can experience anaphylaxis if they touch, inhale or ingest even the slightest trace or residue of the allergen.

To help make school a fun and safe place for our increasing number of peanut- and tree nut-allergic students, we're becoming a peanut- and tree-nut-free school. In addition to cleaning hands and mouths before entering school, here's how you can help:

Lunches

Send lunches with items that contain no peanuts, tree nuts, peanut butter, or nut butter.

Shared Items

- Read labels to ensure shared items, party food and craft materials, contain no peanuts or tree nuts, no traces
 of peanuts or tree nuts, and are not manufactured in a facility or on equipment that processes peanuts or tree
 nuts.
- Provide shared items in their original, unopened packages.
- All shared items requiring advance preparation, such as cutting, will be prepared in the school by a school staff member to avoid cross contamination from in-home utensils and surfaces.

Birthdays

- Consider sending non-food birthday treats, such as a new or used book, game or activity to be shared in class and either donated to the classroom or returned home.
- Food items will only be given once a child has had permission from a parent to accept it and it must be
 presented in a container which shows all ingredients.

Play time

Children must not bring in leather footballs to use at playtimes. The school provides a choice of toys and games for all key stages use.

The correct size leather balls will be used for P.E. but they are supplied by Miss McCormick.

Bikes / Scooters

Please can I remind you that children AND adults must dismount in Durdells Avenue, or Creasey Road, and push these vehicles into school to put safely in the bike shed.
