
Learning together in faith, hope and love

# High expectations of learning outcomes for all

### R.E.

TOPIC 1: Creation-we will focus on how God created us in his image and how it is our responsibility to look after God's world.

TOPIC 2: Sacraments- we look at THE Old Testament and how God calls people in faith which creates

A 'calling' or 'vocation'. This relates to how we are called to recognise God's presence in the world today.

In our **Science** this half term, we will be looking at <u>solids, liquids and</u> <u>gases</u> Our focus will be to:

- Examine the differences between solids, liquids and gases.
- Learn about how particles behave in each state.
- Learn about the water cycle
- Understand the terms: evaporation and condensation
- Learn (from a Wessex water visitor) about how water is purified.

#### Reading

We will have daily reading

comprehension activities whilst looking at a

wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction

and reference books. In doing this, we will become

more familiar with a wide range of books, including myths, legends and traditional stories and modern fiction.

### Our **History** topic is about the Tudors.

The aim of this topic is:

-To develop an understanding about Tudor Britain.

-To extend our chronological

modelled writing, then imitating and innovating writing in different contexts (narrative &non fiction)

There will be daily spelling practise & activities which will also be practised at home.

### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths this half term, the focus will be on:

- Understanding the value of each digit in a 4 digit number (place value)
- Recognising, ordering and comparing 3 and 4 digit numbers on a numberline (including decimal numbers.)
- Addition & subtraction written methods to solve 2 step word problems.
- Regular times tables practice to develop quick recall.

In **PE** this term, we will continue to develop a healthy and positive approach to sport and exercise. Our main focus will be on athletic and invasion games. This will include team games including

throwing and catching ball skills.

#### Geography:

• Use maps, atlases & globes to locate countries in Europe relating to Tudor Queens.

#### <u>Music</u>

- Recognise & understand pentatonic scales
- Compose a Chinese song
