Home Learning

Please continue to read with your child daily and practise their sounds in their letters and sounds folders. Don't forget to play games such as Georgie's Gym that we talked about in the Phonics Workshop to support your child's blending skills and I-Spy which will support initial sounds. Play lots of games that involve counting and encourage your child to talk about things that you do, supporting them to use the correct tense when they speak eg. "I did this" instead of "I done this".
