The tests will take place **between Monday 9th May and Thursday 12th May.**

We will be sending out a video presentation, which will contain more information regarding the week. We will notify you once this has been emailed out.

On each of the SATs mornings, we will be asking the children to come into school at 8:10am for breakfast to help them settle and make sure they sit the tests on a full stomach, ensuring the best possible success for them. They will also have a short physical activity and meditation before they start the test. We are asking for a contribution of **£2 each** towards the four days of breakfast. The breakfasts will include different options on each day such as: cereal, beans on toast, sausages, bacon, toast, fruit and fresh juice.

On Thursday 12th May, we will be having a sausage and chips lunch to celebrate the children's resilience and successes of the week. If you wish for your child to take part in this lunch, **they will need to pay £3 each**. Children are welcome to bring in a small fizzy drink of their choice for this lunch. If your child would prefer to bring their own lunch in and not have the sausage and chips, they are welcome to.
