Uniform:

Please ensure all your child's uniform is NAMED including P.E. kits.

Long hair should be tied back every day - no Jojo bows.

Please make sure your child always has a jumper and a coat as our weather is very unpredictable!

PE:

We will have PE every Tuesday and Wednesday. Please ensure your child has a fully named PE kit.

Fit Friday:

Each Friday children will come to school in their PE kit.

Music:

Mrs Fisher will teach music on a Tuesday (Swans) or Wednesday (Robins).

Handwriting:

All children are learning to hold their pencil and form their letters correctly. It is very important that your child practises at home.

Home Learning:

Work will be sent home on a Friday and needs returning by the following Wednesday.

- Reading every day at least 5 times per week. Please sign your child's reading record book. Please ensure that your child's reading book and reading record are with them every day at school.
- Phonics activities will be sent home to reinforce learning.
- Practise Maths Skills number recognition, counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s, number bonds to 10/20
- Children have access to Bug Club, Doodle Maths

Reward Systems:

Each child in Year 1 can earn stickers for their sticker chart. When they have filled up their sticker chart they will be able to choose a prize from the 'Wow Box' each sticker represents a 'house point'.

We have a rainbow system for behaviour in our class. Please refer to our behaviour policy for more information.

We have Golden Assembly every Friday. Two children from the class will be awarded with a Golden Certificate.

Children can bring in certificates/medals/trophies from home to show in assembly.

Box of Me:

On a **Friday** each week a child in class will be chosen to bring home the 'Box of Me'. At home they need to look around the house for objects that represent who they are.
