#### English:

- \*In reading, children will be continuing to develop comprehension skills, using skimming and scanning skills to retrieve information from a given text.
- \*The children will continue to use given texts in order to unpick the writers' viewpoints and feelings.
- \*The children will be writing persuasive letters, diary entries and instruction texts. They will also be planning and writing their own invented stories.



- \*Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and have never been alive.
- \*Identify habitats of living things and why they are suited to those places, linking this to our texts in English.
- \*Explore basic needs of all living things and their food chains.

#### Maths:

- \*Children will tell and write the time using quarter past, quarter to and up to 5 minutes.
- \*Children will sequence and compare intervals of time.
- \*Children will learn to read scales to measure mass, temperature and capacity.
- \*Children will continue to learn multiplication facts mentally and their division facts, and use these to solve maths problems.
