Dinner served at 5.30pm-burgers and chips.

Breakfast served at 8am- cooked sausages and egg bread/ toast/ cereal.

Over the course of the day the children will experience 3 activities-e.g. adventure playground, low team games and trampoline.

Lunch at 1pm- sandwiches, fruit and juice.
