If you would like to speak to us at any point, we will always be on the door at the end of the day to answer any questions as best we can.

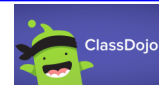

We are currently in the process of hearing all children read and completing phonics assessments to ensure they are on the right level. Please do bear with us!

Times Tables

At the end of Year 4, every child will be tested on their times tables knowledge. It is vital that the children are getting **daily practice**.

We will start in class with **x10, x5 and x2**, then continue on to x3, x4 and x8. The more your child can learn this year, will make Year 4 so much easier!
