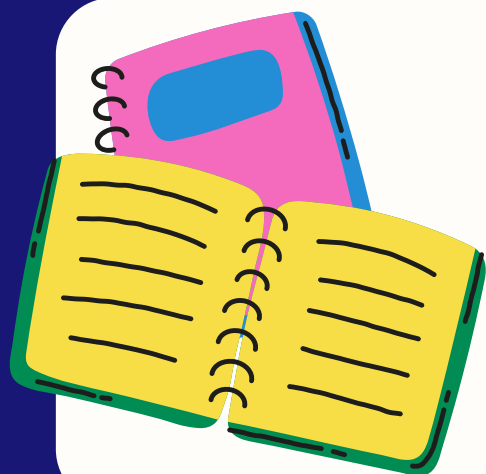

# Attendance

Being at school every day is very important because regular school attendance helps children fulfil their potential and gives them a better chance for the future. A school year is 190 days, this leaves 175 days to spend with family, on holiday, shopping and those essential appointments. The national average for children attending school is 96%. 90% attendance over the course of the school year is the equivalent to a day off every fortnight.

## CTK Attendance

The national average for attendance is 95.8%. Our average school attendance this term is 94.7%. This is an area that the school are working to improve daily. Pupils in KS1 have attendance above the national average at 96% closely followed by pupils in Year 5 where their attendance is 95%. Out of the 305 pupils on roll **112 pupils have 100% attendance.**
