Dear Parents,

Thank you for supporting your children with their first half term in Year 2—please ensure you note all diary dates listed below that have been passed to us for this half term so far. As usual, any further dates or changes will be notified via Class Dojo as our primary source of communication.

This half term has lots of learning linked to Historical events and, as Historians, the children will learn about some of the important people and events that have shaped our past—The Gunpowder Plot, Remembrance Day and The Great Fire of London. We will use non fiction texts as well as narratives to explore events from differing characters viewpoints. Throughout this half term learning will link with our <u>Gospel Value questions 'Was everyone in the past Peaceful? How did people in the past show their Courage?'</u>

In Maths children will begin to learn Year 2 Addition and Subtraction skills, applying previously learned knowledge of number bonds and partitioning within these lessons. Spellings will continue to reflect the curriculum in Year 2 and often will incorporate spelling rules children are being taught and can also recognise in their Reading—it is important to make a strong link with spellings being present across their learning.

Key Information and <u>Reminders</u>
