Dear Parents.

We look forward to welcoming you and your children back to school! Year 5's engagement has been amazing throughout the last 8 weeks and we would like to commend you all on your fantastic support throughout the lockdown. Your children are all extremely lucky to have parents like you.

Moving forwards, expectations will remain the same: we expect children to be reading (with a signature) and completing spellings daily. We will also be setting homework weekly for the children to complete (set on a Friday and collected in on a Wednesday). All homework will be set on Google Classroom.

Our topic when we return to school is Ancient Greece; this is a continuation of the topic from the last half term. We have lots of exciting activities planned for the children including: learning about Greek Gods and Goddesses, writing a mythical play script and designing/making hand puppets to help act them out, lots of physical activity and many practical science activities.

Please remember that your child's attendance and punctuality is paramount, we start teaching at **8.30am**; this is the time that we expect **all children** to be in our classrooms. Year 5 children can walk to and from school entrance/exits, we will need a signed letter giving permission (if you haven't already).
